Iiyama City, Nagano

Iiyama City, Nagano is known as "snow country's little Kyoto" for its many temples and shrines, which visitors can enjoy while walking around the city. In addition, the tradition and culture of Iiyama live on in traditional handicrafts. Iiyama's uchiyama paper is created by laying raw materials for paper on the snow to bleach, and Iiyama-made Buddhist altars are enriched by the local faith, as well as optimal weather for lacquering techniques.

Iiyama City also has some of the heaviest snowfall in the world. The city offers a way of life and natural scenery available only in snow country, including the giant beech trees of Mt. Nabekura and the Chikumagawa (also known as the Shinanogawa), Japan's longest river. This gorgeous natural landscape represents Japan's "original hometown scenery," which fascinates many visitors. Hokuriku Shinkansen Iiyama Station opened in March 2015 and now, you can get to the nature wonderland from Tokyo within 2hours.

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
